APPRENTICE INTAKE PROCESS

The Intake Process Is A Four-Stage Process As Follows:

Stage 1: The Application
Stage 2: The Aptitude Test*
Stage 3: The Interview

Stage 4: Mandatory 2 Week Safety Training & Orientation*

Complete details will be provided to applicants at the time of application.

NOTE: Applications <u>MUST</u> be completed in person at the Local 285 Training Centre between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM Monday through Friday.

Deadline for applications will be 3:00 PM on Friday March 29th, 2019

Stage 1: The Application

The following are the requirements for a valid submission.

- You must have your Social Insurance card or an official document with proof of SIN
- You must provide an acceptable form of government issued Photo ID
- You <u>must</u> submit your high school transcript, diploma, or provide a copy of a valid
 Sheet Metal Worker Apprenticeship Training Agreement as proof of education
- You <u>must</u> have a minimum of grade 10 education. If schooling was completed abroad, equivalency in education must be recognized by a regulatory body
- You <u>must</u> be able to complete a 2-week Safety Training and Orientation Course, ensuring punctual attendance each day
- You may also provide a letter of recommendation from your parent/grandparent or family member who is a member of Local 285 and/or a Local 285 signatory contractor
- A driver's license is an asset, G2, M2 or better
- Applications can only be filled out by the individual applying and must be completed in person. Applications may at no time leave the premises
- You may submit other post secondary transcripts, other related course certificates, and a resume to be included with your application

* DATES AND TIMES FOR THE APTITUDE TEST AND THE 2 WEEK SAFETY TRAINING AND ORIENTATION WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE TIME OF APPLICATION.
