## **APPRENTICE INTAKE PROCESS- Four Stage Process**

<u>Stage 1: The Application</u> <u>Stage 2: The Aptitude Test</u> <u>Stage 3: The Interview</u>

Stage 4: Mandatory 1 Week Safety Training & Orientation

NOTE: Deadline for applications will be 3:00 PM on Monday August 31, 2020. Failure to provide required documents may result in you being turned away.

## The following are the requirements for a valid submission

## **Stage 1: The Application**

- Applications are available online at <u>www.smwia285.ca</u>. Print and complete the application and attach all supporting documents as mentioned below.
- You <u>must</u> include a copy of your high school transcript, diploma, or provide a copy of a valid Sheet Metal Worker Apprenticeship Training Agreement as proof of education.
- You <u>must</u> have a minimum of grade 10 education. If schooling was completed abroad, equivalency in education must be recognized by a regulatory body.
- You may also include a letter of recommendation from your parent/grandparent or family member who is a member of Local 285 and/or a Local 285 signatory contractor.
- You may also include other post-secondary transcripts, other related course certificates, and a resume to be included with your application.
- You can email your application with documents to <a href="mailto:info@285training.ca">info@285training.ca</a> using "Apprenticeship Intake" and your name in the subject line or drop off at the union office in an envelope marked "Apprenticeship Intake" with your name.

### Stage 2: The Aptitude Test

- DATES AND TIMES FOR THE APTITUDE TEST WILL BE PROVIDED BY EMAIL AFTER STAGE 1 THE APPLICATION PROCESS HAS BEEN RECEIVED.
- Your application may be verified at time of Aptitude Test
- To Write the Aptitude Test You <u>must</u> show your Social Insurance card or an official document with proof of SIN
- To Write the Aptitude Test You must show an acceptable form of government issued Photo ID

#### **Stage 3: The Interview**

You will be notified if and when you need to attend the interview.

### Stage 4: Mandatory 1 Week Safety Training & Orientation

- You <u>must</u> be able to complete a 1-week Safety Training and Orientation Course, ensuring punctual attendance each day.
- A driver's license is an asset, G2, M2 or better
- DATES FOR THE 1 WEEK SAFETY TRAINING AND ORIENTATION ARE SEPTEMBER 21-25, 2020 AND NOVEMBER 23-27, 2020.
