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APPRENTICE INTAKE: Four Stage Process

Stage 1: The Application Stage 2: The Aptitude Test

Stage 3: The Interview

Stage 4: Mandatory 2 Week Safety Training & Orientation

NOTE: Deadline for applications will be 3:00 PM on Friday April 29, 2022.

Failure to provide all required documents by the date of your interview, if selected, may result in your application not being processed any further.

The following are the requirements for a valid submission

Stage 1: The Application

- Applications are available **online at <u>www.smwia285.ca</u>**. Complete the application and attach all supporting documents as mentioned below.
- You <u>must</u> include a copy of your high school transcript, diploma, or provide a copy of a valid Sheet Metal Worker Apprenticeship Training Agreement as proof of education.
- You <u>must</u> have a minimum of grade 10 education. If schooling was completed abroad, equivalency in
 education must be recognized by a regulatory body.
- You may also include a letter of recommendation from your parent/grandparent or family member who is a member of Local 285 and/or a Local 285 signatory contractor.
- You may also **include** other post-secondary transcripts, other related course certificates, and a resume to be included with your application. Do not email your government ID or proof of SIN.
- You can email your application with documents to info@285training.ca using "Apprenticeship Intake" and your name in the subject line or drop off at the union office in an envelope marked "Apprenticeship Intake" with your name.

Stage 2: The Aptitude Test

- ONCE YOUR APPLICATION HAS BEEN RECEIVED, YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF YOUR APTITUDE TEST DATE AND TIME BY EMAIL WITHIN 2-3 BUSINESS DAYS TO THE EMAIL ADDRESS PROVIDED ON YOUR APPLICATION. PLEASE BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR JUNK FOLDER.
- Your application may be verified at time of Aptitude Test
- To Write the Aptitude Test You <u>must</u> show: (do not email the following to us)
 - your Social Insurance card or an official document with proof of SIN
 - o an acceptable form of government issued photo ID

Stage 3: The Interview

- All applicants will be notified by email to the email address provided on your application, whether you are selected to attend the interview or not.
- Do not contact the Union or Training Centre to inquire if you have been selected.

Stage 4: Mandatory 2 Week Safety Training & Orientation

- You <u>must</u> be able to complete a 2-week Safety Training and Orientation Course, ensuring punctual attendance each day.
- DATES FOR THE 2 WEEK SAFETY TRAINING AND ORIENTATION ARE AS FOLLOWS:
 Orientation 1: MAY 30-JUNE 10, 2022 and Orientation 2: JULY 4-15, 2022.
